Planning for more convenient, connected mobility

The RTC of Southern Nevada was awarded a federal grant in 2023 to develop a plan for expanding reliable, affordable travel choices in areas with limited transportation options. The All-Access Mobility Plan will identify a handful of potential mobility hub locations, and the features they could include, should funding become available.

What is a mobility hub?

A mobility hub is a **one-stop connection point** for transportation options. It's a place where different types of transportation options come together, often with helpful services and features that make your trip easier and more comfortable.

Imagine stepping off the bus at a stop where you can easily rent a bike or catch an on-demand shuttle for the last leg of your trip. Or where you can grab a coffee and comfortably wait for a connecting bus under a large shade structure. That's what a mobility hub can provide!

What could a mobility hub include?



Enhanced bus stops



Small retail shops



Bike share



Rideshare pick-up zones



Shade, seating, lighting



Small parks and playgrounds



Safe connections to sidewalks and bike lanes



And so much more!

Where is the study area?

The planning study is focused on identifying potential locations for neighborhood mobility hubs in and around downtown Las Vegas, the Historic Westside, downtown North Las Vegas, and a portion of the Eastside.



Why it matters

Mobility hubs expand transportation options and make it easier, safer, and more convenient for everyone—especially those without a car.

- Transit use in the project area is 2x the regional average.
- Nearly 1 in 5 households don't own a vehicle in the study area.
- More mobility options mean better access to jobs, healthcare, food, and other essentials.

While funding for transit infrastructure is currently limited, completing this plan is an important first step in positioning RTC for future implementation, should funding become available. The RTC is currently seeking a long-term, sustainable funding solution for the region's public transportation system.
