## The Mobility For All Training Series

### Empowering Local Leaders to Create Inclusive Transportation Solutions

As part of the [All-Access Mobility Plan](#) (AAMP), the Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada (RTC) is launching the [Mobility For All Training Series](#) — a hands-on learning opportunity designed to strengthen local capacity for community-centered transportation planning and investment. Led by **Charles T. Brown**, a nationally-recognized planning and policy expert, this series brings together public sector professionals, community advocates, and local leaders who are passionate about expanding access and improving mobility in underserved neighborhoods.

#### What Participants Will Gain

Participants will build knowledge and practical skills to:

- **Reimagine transportation investments** to better serve all community members
- **Explore and apply core principles** of mobility for all
- **Center people-first, community-driven decision-making** in planning and infrastructure projects

#### A Collaborative Learning Experience

Participants will apply what they learn by helping shape the strategies and priorities of the AAMP and contribute to the development of the **Mobility For All Investment Guide** — a resource to support thoughtful, community-based transportation decisions in the AAMP study area and beyond.

While tailored to the AAMP, this guide will also serve as a model that can be adapted for other projects across Southern Nevada.

**Training Series Overview** – The series consists of five free, in-person sessions, each focused on a specific topic:

**Session 1: Foundations of Accessible Mobility**

**Session 2: Strategic Selection of Mobility Hub Locations**

**Session 3: People-Centered Mobility Planning**

**Session 4: Policy & Investment Strategies**

**Session 5: Report-Out & Completion Celebration**

### Participant Outcomes

- **Build practical skills** to apply community-centered planning to mobility investments
- **Co-create the Mobility For All Investment Guide**, a new resource for decision making
- **Earn a Certificate of Completion**, useful for grant applications and organizational recognition
- **Network** with local leaders and public-sector staff
- **Receive public recognition** from the RTC
